We continue to follow the Data Protection Act 1998.

Personal data is held by the school / Local Authority about those employed or otherwise engaged to work at the school or Local Authority. We will not give information about you to anyone outside the school or Local Authority (LA) without your consent unless the law and our rules allow us to.
