3DW Home Learning Ideas

- 1. Write postcard messages to other people in your family / friends and post them, email messages.
- 2. Research about a topic of interest to you (London, British Isles, Famous landmarks in the UK). Record key words and information / phrases.
- 3. Create your own newspaper article or mini newspaper using pictures, photos and simple paragraphs to give information.
- 4. Create simple maps draw map of bedroom, house, garden; add a simple compass rose to show north, east, south, west.
- 5. Look at maps of local areas. How could you get to different places?
- 6. Read a book and write a review. Look at nonfiction books and discuss the contents; use index page to find key information.
- 7. Play games using turn-taking, number skills and reading skills. Play other games such as puzzles, throwing, catching, memory games and card games.
- 8. Access <u>www.twinkl.com</u> and singing hands on you tube to use Makaton signs.
- 9. Time how long it takes to complete different activities drink a drink, run from one end of garden to other end, read a sentence etc.
- 10. Cooking activities reinforcing how we use measurement.
- 11. Discuss stories ask questions (who, what, why, where).
- 12. Watch BBC Newsround daily and discuss information given what do they think? https://www.bbc.co.uk/newsround/news/watch_newsround
- 13. Look at animal lifecycles.
- 14. Sequence events in a story and write character profiles using adjectives.
- 15. Draw characters and scenes and write captions of what characters are saying.
