1. Role play, create a shop and buy items using coins (up to £1)
2. Write a letter to your school friends.
3. Active maths – Listen and dance to Jack Hartman (a class favourite)

4. Keep active to Just dance online (YouTube).
5. Create a video blog – record your daily experiences of staying at home. We can share these when back at school.
6. Minecraft coding - <https://code.org/minecraft>
7. Explore the garden or park. Water the plants, make a bird feeder, and decorate the trees in eco-friendly decorations.
8. Share a book and encourage finding illustrations, asking some questions (who, what, where questions ... how many? Shall we sign? etc).
9. Cooking – help the family with cooking simple meals. Encourage self-help and independence. Can you create your own recipe?
10. Make your own daily fitness plan. Dance, star jumps, bouncing on a trampoline, climbing.
11. Build a fort – use cushions, sheets, house hold items to create your own den (make sure you clean up after yourselves!)
12. Storytime Phonics is the phonics programme taught at school, you can access the stories for each sound on YouTube.
13. Create a sensory space. Think about lighting, sounds, touch smells.
