Focusing on weather and the different types of things to do in weather some things you might like to do at home are:

Watch films or read stories about weather and climate change such as: cloudy with a chance of meatballs, twister, happy feet, the lorax

Build a den or shelter in the garden using different materials. How strong is it? Will it protect from different weather - rain, wind, sun?

Conduct different science weather experiments - storm in a jar, make a rainbow, colours worksheets.

Weather sorting activities - suitcase activity, sort clothes to different weather cards

Maths - play games rounding to nearest 10, 100 or 1000. You could use 30 buttons, cubes, blocks whatever you have to cover the squares (or make your own counters)

Time - sequence the days of the week, map out times of the day when you do different things, draw the things that you do on different days of the week / identify times using o'clock, half past, quarter past, quarter to.

Time how long it takes for you to do different activities or exercises, how many can be done in a minute?

Label different types of food that you have around the house - match to weather. What foods would you eat more of in summer / winter?

Draw the main characters from stories or films and write captions for them, describe what they look like, how they act etc.

Money - make sure own shop at home and write the price tags. Make shopping lists to buy and calculate costs of foods.

Look at the different weights of foods, weigh foods, cooking recipes using different foods

Make different foods using play dough, plasticine

Division and fractions - share out different foods

Make a volcano

Create a storm using sensory items such as instruments, pots, pans, dark coloured cloth, torch, spray bottle

Dance to different weather music - storm to calm, tornado

Look at changes - coping strategies ow have things changed during lock down / isolation/ shielding with covid - 19 virus? Design a poster about coping strategies - how to stay safe.

Learn about the water cycle

Look at the effects that water has on different materials - soil, sand

Food hygiene / preparation and recycling - make models using recycled materials (could photograph and email to teacher)

Water play / sensory tray with sand, corn flour, rice

How do you stay safe in different weather conditions? - create carton strips, write simple instructions, draw and label pictures / products

Research different / favourite holiday destinations - create an advert for favourite place

Meditation/ mindfulness to calming weather sounds, music

Learn about opposites - hot / cold, heavy / light: find different objects

Capacity measuring different objects and record weights, sequence weights

Make your own book / leaflet about the weather, holiday destinations, staying safe in different weather conditions

Record your own weather report

Blow painting / splat painting

Make a kite

Compare fiction stories and non-fiction texts about the weather. Can you recall and locate information / facts?

Coordinates - find different places areas on maps / around the house/ garden. Draw a compass and label
