### Literacy-Phonics

- Sound Hunt game: Go for a walk- try and choose a quiet time- otherwise spend some time in your garden if you have one. Ask an adult or older brother or sister to make a tick sheet for you and list: plane, lorry, car, motorbike, train (if you live near a railway line), bird, dog, cat, chicken, children, adults talking, add any other sounds you hear to your chart. Tick all sounds that you hear.
- Join in 'Clap for carers' on Thursday nights at 8pm:
  - 1 Start clapping quietly, then clap louder and louder.
  - 2 Find something in the house with your child that makes a noise such as a saucepan and spoon
  - 3 Help your child to make an instrument to bang or shake

- Play Eye Spy – play in different places in/outside your home or on a walk
- Choose a letter of the week (start with: s, a, t, p, i, n)  
Find a range of objects beginning with the letter and add a few beginning with other letters. Encourage your child to find objects beginning with the letter. If you don't have enough objects print off clear pictures.
- Watch your chosen letter of the week on Alphablocks.

- Play a fun version of Kim's Game – place a range of 3 letter objects (or pictures/photos) onto a table or floor inside or other hard surface or blanket in the garden. Sound out all the objects and then name the object e.g. b-o-x box. The adult or older sibling then covers the objects and feels under the cover and sounds out the object. The child can then guess the object and then sound out the object again with the adult or older sibling.

Some useful words: box, pen, pot, bed, cup, mug, car, hat, van, bus, cat, dog, cow, fox, pig, hat, mum, dad.
